Year after year, the world sees the violence in the Middle East and how Christians are being forced to flee this area that is so sacred to our faith. It is a tragedy happening right before our eyes. 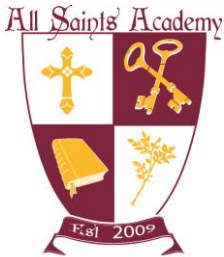

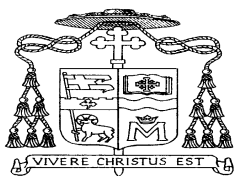
