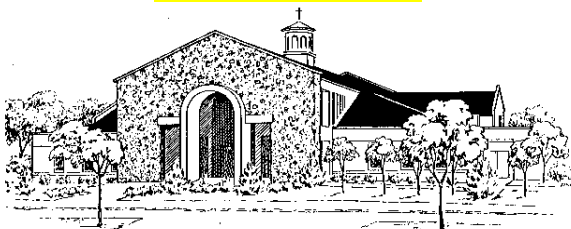

**PADRE PIO PRAYER GROUP JULY AT 3:00 PM**

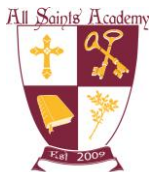
