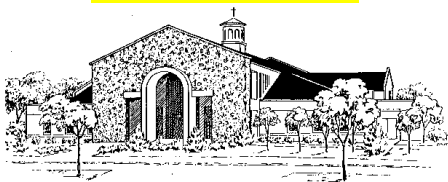

### WHAT KIND OF FASTING IS THE LORD ASKING FOR US?

“This is the kind of fasting I have chosen... to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor with shelter” Isaiah 58:7  
The season of Lent is approaching when God showed His greatest love for us in Jesus. It's at this time when we feel we want to align ourselves more closely with the Suffering Jesus. Perhaps we can do that by following the suggestion of the Prophet Isaiah through our Lenten Christian Service Project, which has become a tradition for our parish.

The Good Samaritans are again sponsoring a “Simple Soup-er Meal” on four Fridays during lent... March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> and April 7<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 – 7:00 PM in the Church Hall. #### HELP OBTAIN SAFE RIDES TO SCHOOL FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOL CHILDREN

##### PROBLEM:

1. Current Catholic school students can only obtain a ride to school for a maximum of \$884 per student.
2. Many bus companies and school districts are unwilling/unable to transport students at the \$884 rate.
3. The ceiling should match cost of living increases, which has not happened since the 2007/2008 school year.

##### WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Ask the Governor to increase funding for nonpublic school transportation in his Fiscal Year 2017 Budget. If your family has been affected by this problem, or you know of families who have, tell the Governor the details. Even if the bussing problem does not apply to you, but you believe in Catholic education, please contact Governor Christie.
