**THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER**  
**100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA**

This year 2017 marks the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady to the three shepherd children at Fatima, Portugal, where the Blessed Mother appeared once each month from May 13 until Oct. 13, 1917. The message of Fatima highlights many central truths and devotions of our Catholic faith: the Blessed Trinity, the Holy Eucharist, penance, the Rosary and sacrifices for the conversion of sinners. There is special emphasis on the Immaculate Heart of Mary, a refuge of maternal love for us all and a sure path leading us to God. Mary's Immaculate Heart will triumph because she is full of God's grace and all holy. Mary has a mother's heart caring for all of us, her children, and wants us to be saved by Jesus, her divine Son.

Fatima is one of the most significant of all Marian apparitions. Along with Guadalupe (Dec. 12) and Lourdes (Feb. 11), it is one of three Marian apparitions honored with a feast day. In 2002, Pope St. John Paul II added the May 13 feast of Our Lady of Fatima to the general Roman calendar. May 13 was the day of the first Fatima apparition of 1917, and May 13, 1981, was the day when St. John Paul II survived an attempt on his life in St. Peter's Square. He credited his survival to the intervention of Our Lady of Fatima. The assassin's bullet that narrowly missed killing the pope now is inserted in a crown of Our Lady housed at the Fatima shrine. Fatima is also linked with the collapse of Soviet communism more than 25 years ago.

Some 4-5 million people visit Fatima each year, and more are expected for the centennial year. Pope Francis will visit Fatima on May 13<sup>th</sup>, the anniversary of Mary's first appearance to the children. Pray for the Pope that day.

I ask you to offer here a Novena Prayer which I ask you to personally pray to Mary for 9 days, beginning this Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup> and concluding on Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Please put all our most important prayer intentions into this Novena Prayer.



### MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO:

#### 100° ANIVERSARIO DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE FATIMA

Este año 2017 marca el centenario de las apariciones de Nuestra Señora a los tres pastorcitos de Fátima, Portugal, donde la Santísima Madre apareció una vez al mes desde el 13 de mayo hasta el 13 de octubre de 1917. El mensaje de Fátima destaca muchas verdades centrales y devociones de nuestra fe católica: la Santísima Trinidad, la Sagrada Eucaristía, la penitencia, el Rosario y los sacrificios por la conversión de los pecadores. Hay un énfasis especial en el Corazón Inmaculado de María, un refugio del amor maternal para todos nosotros y un camino seguro que nos lleva a Dios. El Inmaculado Corazón de María triunfará porque está llena de la gracia de Dios y de todo lo santo. María tiene el corazón de una madre cuidando de todos nosotros, sus hijos, y quiere que seamos salvados por Jesús, su Hijo divino.



Fátima es una de las más significativas de todas las apariciones marianas. Junto con Guadalupe (12 de diciembre) y Lourdes (11 de febrero), es una de las tres apariciones marianas honradas con un día de fiesta. En el 2002, el Papa San Juan Pablo II añadió el 13 de mayo, la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Fátima al calendario romano general. El 13 de mayo fue el día de la primera aparición de Fátima en el 1917 y el 13 de mayo de 1981 fue el día en que San Juan Pablo II sobrevivió a un atentado contra su vida en la Plaza de San Pedro. Él atribuyó su supervivencia a la intervención de Nuestra Señora de Fátima. 

