FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
THE WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

This Fourth Sunday of Easter weekend is a special celebration that we call Good Shepherd Sunday. Back in 1963, Blessed Pope Paul VI designated the Fourth Sunday of Easter each year as *World Day of Prayer for Vocations*. Our parish joins with the church all over the world to ask God's blessings that every one of us may be strengthened in a Christian vocation. Each year on this Fourth Sunday of Easter, we proclaim a Gospel reading from the 10th chapter of John's Gospel, where Jesus proclaims, "*I am the Good Shepherd.*" (John 10:11) and where He explains what it is to be a Good Shepherd. Please read the complete 10th chapter of Saint John's Gospel this week if you can.

The church honors all Christian vocations today: Marriage, Priesthood, Single Life, Consecrated Life as a Religious Brother or Sister. Life a Jesus gives His life for us that we all may experience the fullness of life. We pray that we are open to God's call and ready to accept the gift of embracing our own vocation completely.

If you are thinking about what your own Christian vocation may be for the future, turn to Jesus in prayer about this. If you are thinking about possibly serving the church directly as a priest or in the consecrated religious life, please speak with one of us priests, deacons or Sister Sylvia here at the parish. Otherwise, speak with a priest or sister who you know personally. It may help a lot to clarify your thoughts.

Jesus told to His disciples and all of us about people giving their lives totally to a vocation serving the Church, "*The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest.*" (Matthew 9: 37-38) Please join me and pray one Our Father every day as your own vocation prayer.

The National Coalition for Church Vocations offers us this beautiful Vocations Prayer which we present to you. Please offer this prayer today on this Good Shepherd Sunday. You can cut it out and put it in your prayer book for each day along with our one daily Our Father for Church vocations.

Gracious God, with grateful hearts we welcome the presence of Jesus, our Good Shepherd.

We accept the mission of Jesus to bring good news to the world by our baptismal
commitment to gospel living.

Bless us with discerning hearts. May we have the courage to give our lives in

Inspire men and women to respond generously and embrace the gift of a religious vocation.

We unite our prayers with the whole Church,
with the communion of saints, with Jesus and the Spirit in praise

Día mundial de la oración por las vocaciones

Este fin de semana, el cuarto domingo de Pascua, es la celebración especial del Domingo del Buen Pastor. En 1963, el Papa Pablo VI designó el cuarto domingo de Pascua de cada año, como el Día Mundial de la *Oración por las Vocaciones*. Nuestra parroquia se une a la iglesia universal, para pedirle a Dios la bendición de que cada uno seamos reforzados en una vocación cristiana. Cada año en este 4^{to} Domingo de Pascua, proclamamos una lectura del décimo capítulo del Evangelio de Juan, donde Jesús proclama “Yo soy el buen pastor.” (Juan 10, 11) y donde explica el significado de ser el Buen Pastor. Por favor lea el capítulo 10 completo del Evangelio de San Juan, si puede este fin de semana.

En este día, la iglesia honra todas las vocaciones cristianas hoy: el Matrimonio, el Sacerdocio, la Vida Unica y la Vida Consagrada como Hermano o Hermana Religiosa. Jesús dió su vida para que nosotros también experimentemos la plenitud de la vida. Oramos para que estemos abiertos a la llamada de Dios y listos para aceptar el regalo de vivir completamente nuestras propias vocaciones.

Si estás personalmente discerniendo acerca de cuál será tu propia vocación cristiana para el futuro, por favor dirígete a Jesús en oración. Si estás considerando la posibilidad de servir directamente a la Iglesia en el sacerdocio o la vida religiosa, te exorto a hablar con uno de nuestros sacerdotes o la Hermana Sylvia en la parroquia, o con algún sacerdote o religiosa que ya conozcas. Puede ayudar mucho aclarar tus dudas.

Para vocaciones en servicio a la Iglesia, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos, “la cosecha es abundante pero los trabajadores son pocos. Rueguen, pues, al dueño de la cosecha que envíe

trabajadores a recoger su cosecha.” (Mateo 9, 37-38) Todos nosotros podemos orar sólo un Padrenuestro todos los días, en respuesta a Jesús como nuestra propia oración vocacional.
