A NOVENA FOR THE FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION

This month we honor our Blessed Mother Mary by celebrating three very special feasts. This weekend, Saturday, August 5th we honor the Saint Mary Major Basilica in Rome. This great Basilica was built to remember that the Ecumenical Council of Ephesus in 431 A.D. had acclaimed Mary, the Mother of Jesus, to also be Mary, the Mother of God. This Basilica is the first church in the Western Church dedicated to the honor of Mary, as the Mother of God. "Mater Dei".

Tuesday, August 15th is the Feast of the Assumption, celebrating our belief that Mary's body, as well as her soul, was assumed into heaven at the end of her life here on earth. This is the 4th Glorious Mystery of the Rosary. Tuesday's Marian feast is our summer Holy Day of Obligation. Holy Day Masses will be next Monday evening, August 14th at 7:00 PM and Tuesday, August 15th at 6:45 and 8:00 AM, 12 Noon and 7:00 PM. Please come to Mass here in our parish community.

Later this month on Wednesday, August 22nd, we celebrate the Queenship of Mary, Queen of Heaven and Earth. This is the 5th Glorious Mystery of the Rosary, Mary's coronation as the Queen of Heaven and Earth.

The American Church's National Shrine in Washington, D.C., the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, recently published a beautiful Novena to Our Blessed Mother. We should begin praying this Novena in our personal prayers this Monday on August 7th, and complete the 9 day Novena prayer on Tuesday, August 15th. We will offer the Novena Prayer at all our Masses in these days leading up to the Assumption Feast. Please join your family and every parishioner participating with us to pray this beautiful Novena for your personal intentions and the intentions of everyone praying with us here in August. Thank you.

NOVENA PRAYER IN HONOR OF MARY'S ASSUMPTION

Mary, full of grace, all generations rejoice to call you blessed and to acknowledge the great things that God your Savior has done for you. In preserving you from the stain of sin, God already prepared you to be taken to the place that had been readied for you in heaven. **WE'RE INSTALLING A NEW NARTHEX FLOOR
THANKS TO ALL OF YOU**

Last week, bright and early on Monday morning, July 31, we started replacing the tile floor in the narthex (the entrance lobby) of our Church. Demolition of the original, damaged tile floor took place first. This is heavy duty work. A new and different slip resistant tile floor was then immediately installed. The project is scheduled for completion on Friday, August 4. Recognizing that unforeseen difficulties sometimes come up in work like this, we are prepared to carry the project's completion into this week of August 6. But we really do want to finish everything before this weekend as we have planned with the contractor.

Some generous donations for this project as well as the increased weekly collection offerings that so many of you are contributing ever since our "Moving Forward Growing Stronger Together" appeal in the spring, have made it more affordable for our parish to move forward now with this Church building improvement.

Both our Finance and our Building & Grounds Committees are also preparing our parish to repave a big portion of our parking lot later this summer. This expensive project has been postponed for quite a while. Your generosity in the Bishop's "Partners In Faith" campaign and your larger donations in the parish weekly collection are giving us the confidence to undertake this important repair project for everyone's greater safety and convenience. Thank you so much for making it more feasible to tackle both of these necessary projects this summer.

Este mes honramos a nuestra Santísima Madre María celebrando tres fiestas bien especiales. Este fin de semana, el sábado, 5 de agosto honramos la Basílica de Santa María Mayor en Roma. Esta gran basílica fue construida para recordar que el Concilio Ecuménico de Efeso en 431 A.D. había aclamado a María, la Madre de Jesús, a también ser María, la Madre de Dios. Esta basílica es la primera iglesia en la Iglesia Occidental dedicada al honor de María, como Madre de Dios, “Mater Dei”.

El martes, 15 de agosto es la Fiesta de la Asunción, celebrando nuestra creencia de que el cuerpo de María, así como su alma, fue asumido en el cielo al final de su vida aquí en la tierra.
