Back in 1992, almost 26 years ago, Pope Saint John Paul II designated February 11, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes as the World Day of the Sick”, “*a special time of prayer and sharing, of offering one’s suffering for the good of the Church and of reminding us to see in our sick brothers and sisters the face of Christ who, by suffering, dying and rising, achieved the salvation of humankind*”. This year, because February 11 falls on Sunday, we do not celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes in the Mass liturgy. We still acknowledge here our special relationship to Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes, because of our parish’s beautiful Lourdes shrine outside in the Marian Grotto with lovely statues of Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes, and the little girl, Bernadette, who became a canonized Saint of the Church.

We join with Pope Francis and Saint Pope John Paul to acknowledge and pray for all the sick in our community and all who serve in medical and caregiving work for the benefit of the patients and clients who they serve. We honor and pray with and for the families of our brothers and sisters who are the sick in the community.

I share with you a special prayer to Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes. Please offer this prayer today and during the week.

*O ever Immaculate Virgin, Mother of mercy, health of the sick, refuge of sinners,

LENTEN REGULATIONS



Abstinence and Fasting: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on all the Fridays of Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to observe the Laws of fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.

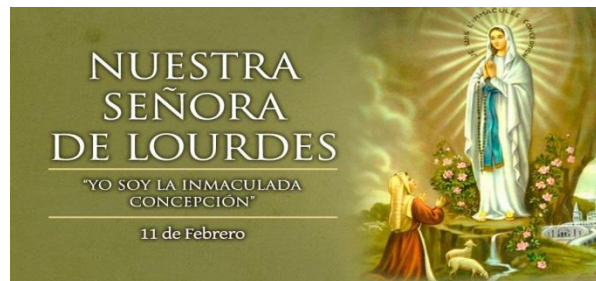

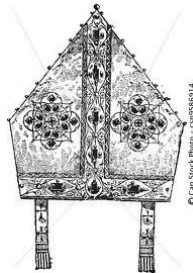
