SAINT PETER’S CHRISTMAS IN JULY FOR BIRTHRIGHT & FOSTER CHILDREN


It has become a tradition that in July our parish reaches out to help newborns and children in foster homes. By reaching out, we express our strong support for the dignity of all life.
