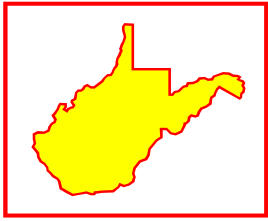

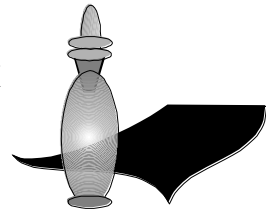

7. **All children treated with Dignity and Respect.**
8. *Clear Rules and Expectations, consistent reinforcement / consequences.*
9. **Adequate supervision of youth. Team approach – accountability – no 1:1 isolation.**
10. **All abuse is reported.**
