SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT**



During that first Advent, in the final month before Jesus was born, Mary and Joseph prepared intensively for His birth. In Luke's infancy Gospel account, the birth of Jesus is presented largely as Mary's story (please read the first two chapters of Luke's Gospel). In Matthew the infancy account is presented more from the perspective of Joseph, her husband (please read the first two chapters of Matthew's Gospel).

This month, the Church blesses us with two special feasts honoring Mary, the Mother of Jesus. We have such a great time honoring Mary as we prepare our hearts to celebrate her giving birth to Jesus. We have just celebrated the Feast of Mary's Immaculate Conception this past Friday, on December 8th. This is Mary's Feast as the Patroness of the United States.

On Tuesday, December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe recalls our Blessed Mother's first appearance in the Western Hemisphere on December 9, 1531 to a layman, Juan Diego, a Native American, in what is today Mexico City. The beautiful image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was painted from heaven on Juan Diego's cloak and presented to the local Bishop who then realized that Mary had visited this man. Devotion to Mary as Our Lady of Guadalupe has increased ever since and today the Church honors Our Lady of Guadalupe as the Patroness of North and South America.

We will celebrate our parish Mass for this great feast on Monday evening, December 11 at 7:00 PM. We invite all parishioners to this Mass for Our Lady of Guadalupe. A multicultural Rosary will be offered before Mass at 6:00 PM. After Mass at 8:15 PM, we will have ethnic foods, raffles and Mariachi music in our parish center (gym). Everyone is invited to come!

Both feasts remind us that as Mary joyfully carried her child before He was born, she was beginning to become our Mother, too. Her love for us, her children, is very much like her love for Jesus, her first born Son, Jesus Christ. Mary's is a mother's love for all of her children. Mary's love blesses all of us. For Advent turn often, even every day, to Mary and to Joseph in your planning, shopping, visiting and celebrating. Ask both Mary and Joseph to help each one of us prepare to celebrate Christmas as the birthday of Mary's son, Jesus Christ, our Savior.

En este mes, la Iglesia nos bendice con dos grandes fiestas honrando a María, la Madre de Jesús. 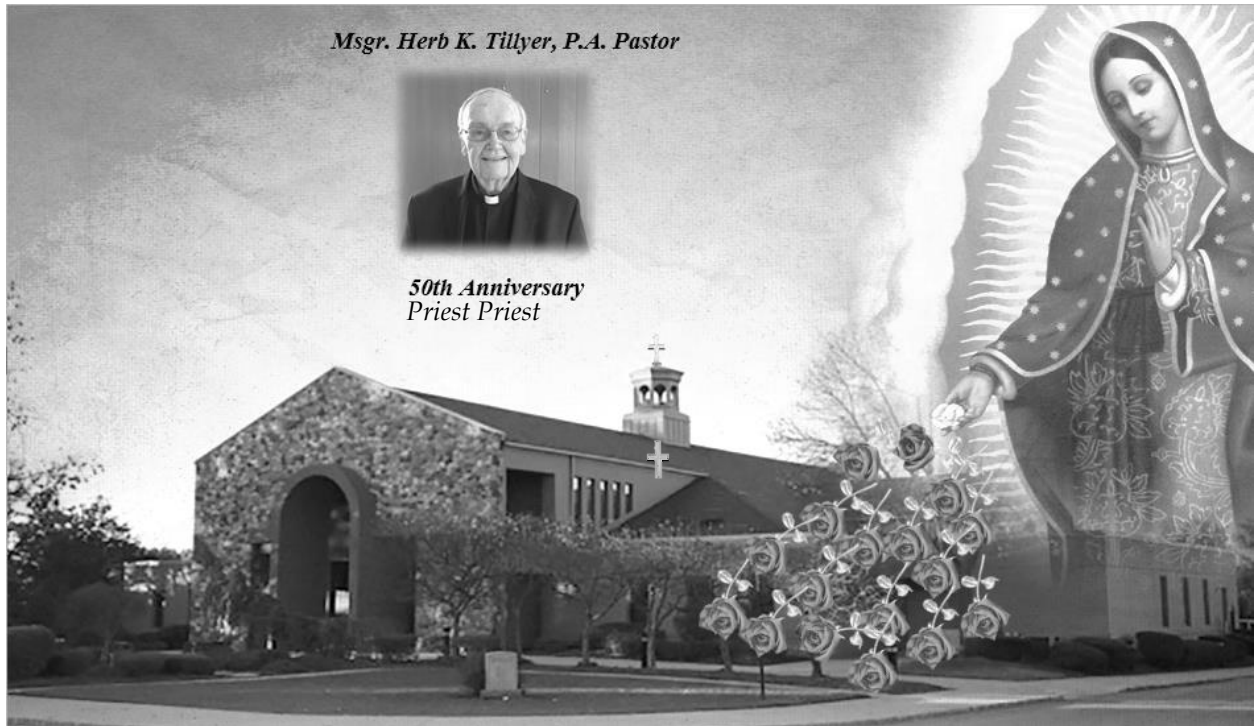
